Note: Expired projects that are re-submitted appear in both the original and subsequent approval years.



#### **POPULATION**


As of January 1, 2010, Frisco's estimated population is 108,201. The city grew at a rate of 7.34% in 2009, adding more than 8,000 residents.

The population at build-out is projected to be approximately 280,000.


#### **2009 Population Growth**




#### **Population Distribution**


#### **RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PERMITS**

New Single-Family construction in remained fairly even from 2008 to 2009, with 919 permits issued for new single-family construction in 2009 compared to 1,064 in 2008.

In 2009, 511 permits were issued for remodels and 454 for additions.

#### **SFR Residential Permit History**






#### **Housing Units Completed in 2009**

Two new multi-family and three new mixed-use residential projects were completed in 2009, for a total of 478 MF units and 1,210 MU units. An additional 769 MF units were opened in 2009 from three projects currently under construction (nearing completion).

826 new single family homes were completed in 2009.


