## **NOTICE**

TAX STATEMENTS ARE REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION SUBMITTAL AND CAN BE OBTAINED AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

1. Go to: https://taxpublic.collincountytx.gov/search

2. Choose a search option and enter one of the following:

**Account Number** Account numbers can be found on your Tax Statement. If you do not

know the account number, try searching by owner name, address or

property location.

Example: XXXXXXXXXXXXX

**Owner Name** Enter owner's last name followed by a space and the first name or

initial.

Example: Doe John or Doe J

**Mailing Address** This is the owner's mailing address. Enter the street number followed

by a space and the street name.

**Property Address** This is the actual property address. Enter the street number, followed

by a space and the street name. Do not enter street type or direction

such as: Ave., Ln., or Dr. **Example:** 100 Weatherford

3. Find the appropriate property record, and click "Details"

4. Click on the "E-Statement" icon

5. Print Statement showing City & School taxes

## **PLEASE NOTE:**

- Unpaid taxes are considered delinquent after January 31<sup>st</sup>. A new tax statement indicating that City taxes are current MUST be provided for any projects submitted and/or expected to be acted upon after January 31st.
- Only City tax certificates are required at submittal.
- City & school tax statement can be obtained at Collin County office and/or web site even if property is in Denton County.
