## **ZONING SIGN CRITERIA**

A zoning sign is a sign erected on the property to publicize a requested Zoning Case or a Specific Use Permit. The number of signs and the placement of signs shall be determined when the First Review Comments are posted for the Zoning and/or Specific Use Permit case.

Property owners/representative may use any sign company to meet zoning sign criteria. To order zoning signs, the applicant should contact a sign company; the sign company will install the zoning sign(s) in location designated by the Planning Division.
