DO RECYCLE

(Place in Blue Recycle Cart)

- Aluminum and steel cans
- Cardboard
- Clean paper food cartons
- Catalogs
- Cereal and dry food boxes
- Envelopes
- Glass (bottles and jars only)
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Paper (white and with color)
- Phone books
- Plastic bottles and containers



DON'T RECYCLE

(Place in Black Trash Cart)

- Aluminum foil
- Ceramic cookware
- Food waste
- Greasy pizza boxes
- Household waste
- Pet waste
- Paper towels and tissues



Thank you for bagging both!

Bagging both your recycling and trash helps prevent lightweight items from becoming litter during service.

Yard trimmings are not allowed in either cart.

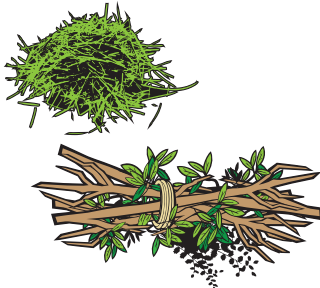
Place **up to 10 bags and/or bundles** of yard waste out for pick-up each week on your regularly scheduled pick-up day. Failure to comply with the following set-out guidelines will result in non-collection.

Grass, leaves, weeds and small plant cuttings:

- Use paper yard waste bags (plastic bags will not be collected).
- Sod, dirt, mulch, rocks, trash or pet waste are not allowed.

Tree limbs:

- Limbs must be less than 4" in diameter and cut into three-foot lengths or smaller.
- Limbs must be bundled with rope or twine.
- Maximum weight may not exceed thirty (30) pounds per bundle.

**Service Schedule Changes
For City-Recognized Holidays**

No trash or recycling services are provided on these days:

New Years Day
Memorial Day
Independence Day

Labor Day
Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day

Monday service moves to Tuesday
Tuesday service moves to Wednesday
Wednesday service moves to Thursday
Thursday service moves to Friday
Friday service moves to Saturday

If your service day should fall on or after one of the above noted holidays within the same week, then your trash/recycling pick up will be provided the next day. When a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delays in service. The schedule will resume as normal the following week.

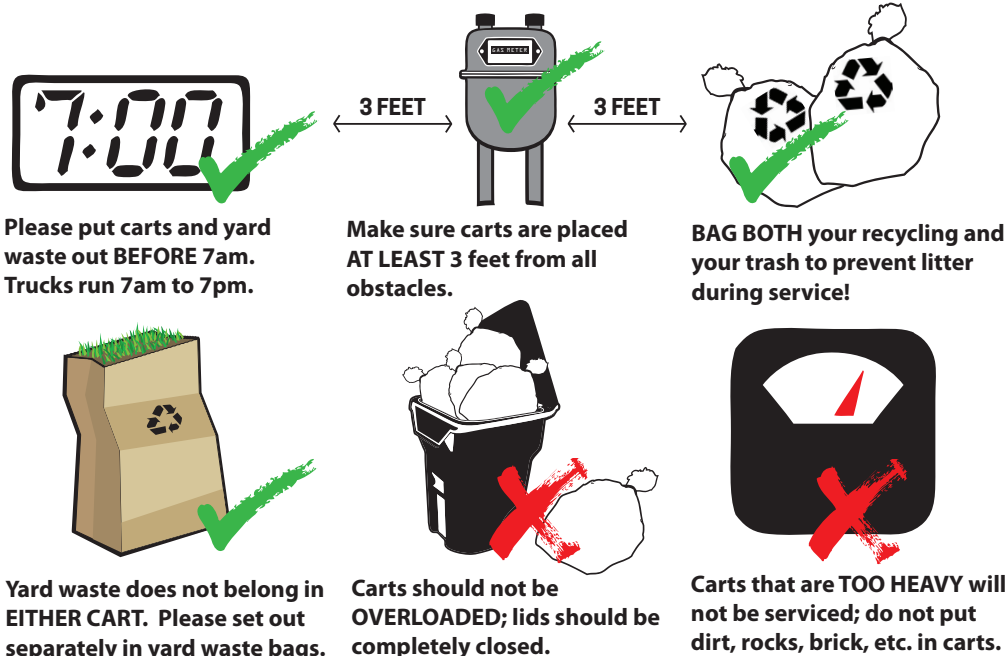
About Your Services

Frisco residents receive the following curbside waste services once per week:

- Bagged household trash (in the black cart)
- Bagged household recycling (in the blue cart)
- Yard waste recycling (in paper yard waste bags)

Set-Out Guidelines

Failure to comply with these set-out guidelines will result in non-collection and may incur charges.



Tips for Smooth Sailing Service

Bag all recycling and trash and place inside respective carts. Items outside of carts will not be collected (excluding yard waste items).

Yard waste, household hazardous waste and construction waste are **NOT ALLOWED** in either cart, as they can cause harmful contamination.

Write your address with a marker in the white space on your cart lids to discourage theft and help locate your carts if they become lost.

Call or email Environmental Services (or use the myFrisco app) to report service problems, missed pick-ups, or broken/damaged carts.

Free Cardboard Recycling Program

Frisco offers a **one-time free cardboard box pickup** to help new move-ins conveniently dispose of their moving boxes and packing paper. If you just moved into a home in Frisco, contact Environmental Services once you're all unpacked, and schedule this one-time free pickup!



Large Metal and Appliance Recycling



Recycle your large metal items with this convenient Thursday pickup. Fill out the form (**online only**) before noon on Wednesday to schedule a pickup appointment for that week. Acceptable items include grills (propane tank removed), basketball poles (detached from base), washers/dryers, lawn mowers (gas and oil removed), etc. A small charge applies.

Please note that a Freon extraction fee applies for refrigerators, freezers, etc.

Do-It-Yourself Trash Disposal

Do-It-Yourself Trash Disposal is available at the Custer Road Transfer Station (9901 Custer Rd. in Plano), Monday - Saturday, 8 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Visits are limited to twice per month. A valid Texas driver's license and current City of Frisco water bill with matching address (original paper copy OR electronic version) are required to access the facility.

Construction debris, dirt, soil, and sod must be taken to the 121 Regional Disposal Facility at 3820 Sam Rayburn Highway. Residents may request one voucher per month for free disposal at this location.

Bulk Pickup

Have trash items too large to fit inside your black cart? With your list of items ready, call 972-292-5900 to schedule. **Must call before noon on the business day prior to your bulk pickup day. Up to 5 large items may be collected per home, per month.**

This pickup is intended for furniture, and may not include remodeling waste, yard waste or boxes/bags of trash. Limits on size, weight, and type of item apply.

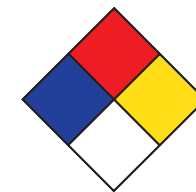
Christmas Tree Recycling

Live holiday trees may be collected and recycled into compost and mulch. Trees that do not meet the following requirements, however, will not be picked up on the regular collection day.

- ✓ **Cut** live trees into sections not to exceed 50 lbs or 4 feet in length.
- ✓ **Remove** all supports, electrical wiring, ornaments, nails, and tinsel.
- ✓ **Place** trees at least 3 feet away from carts on your regular service day.
- ✓ **Do not cover** tree with a plastic bag, as this will prevent pickup.

Please note that artificial and flocked trees are not compostable or recyclable, but may be scheduled for a Bulk Pickup.

Household Hazardous Waste



Household chemicals and electronics should never be placed in trash or recycling carts. Help keep landfills, truck drivers, workers and our neighborhoods safe! Bring Household Hazardous Waste to 6616 Walnut Street during our Special Collection Hours (see below).

SUMMER HOURS
(March - September)

Saturdays 8 a.m. - 1 p.m.

WINTER HOURS
(October - February)

Wednesdays 2 p.m. - 5 p.m.

Saturdays 8 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Valid Texas driver's license and matching current Frisco water bill required.



DURING OUR SPECIAL COLLECTION HOURS ONLY, Frisco residents may drop off the following list of items for recycling or safe disposal:



- Aerosol cans
- Antifreeze
- Large batteries
- Computers
- Electronics
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Gasoline
- Household cleaners
- Ink cartridges
- Lawn products
- Paints and thinners
- Pool chemicals
- Solvents and stains
- Television sets
- Thermometers/thermostats

Please note that it is ILLEGAL to leave hazardous items like these at the Environmental Collection Center outside of Special Collection Hours.

Special Recycling Drop-Off

The following items may be dropped off at our 6616 Walnut Street location during regular hours (Mon - Fri 8 a.m. - 4 p.m., Saturday 8 a.m. - 1 p.m.):



- Mixed household recyclables (into the painted dumpsters)
- Cardboard boxes
- Small household batteries
- Clothing for donations
- EPS (i.e. Styrofoam)
- Grocery bags and plastic film
- Motor oil & filters
- Cooking oil & grease

Choose to Reuse!

The Reuse Center at the Environmental Collection Center offers gently used household products to residents for **FREE** each week, and is open during Special Collection Hours. Driver's license and Frisco water bill are required, and residents must sign waiver form.
