


Revenues and expenses are tracking as projected. As we have discussed, Sales Tax collections are trending above what we had projected this fiscal year. Permit fees are also strong. General Fund expenditures are tracking as expected with 56% of the approved budget expended through the end of May. We have budgeted a decrease in fund balance for FY21 due to the appropriations for the vaccine clinic. Staff is currently compiling a reimbursement request to FEMA to cover the vaccine clinic costs.

Utility revenues and expenses are tracking as expected for this time of year and are consistent with prior year performance.








General Fund Expenditures By Department
