- WHEN AND WHERE?** We have four pre-approved locations for you to choose from. Cottonwood Creek and Trail, Iron Horse Trail (formerly 1135 Trail) and Teal Pond and can be completed at a time that is convenient for you or your group ( Due to social distancing, no groups larger than 10, at this time). - HOW CAN YOU HELP?** Help us keep our parks and natural areas healthy and beautiful! We ask that you spend no more than 3 hours (per shift) picking up litter and removing weeds at the natural area of your choice. Our operations team is happy to remove full garbage bags for you—simply email the date/time/location of your cleanup to [volunteer@friscotexas.gov](mailto:volunteer@friscotexas.gov) and leave full garbage bags near the trail.
- SHOW OFF YOUR WORK!** Due to the self-directed nature of these opportunities, we require proof of work before approving your volunteer hours. Please email Kristina Daniel - Volunteer Coordinator at [volunteer@friscotexas.gov](mailto:volunteer@friscotexas.gov) when you've completed your hours. In the email, please include the natural area you chose, the number of volunteer hours completed, and before/after photos of the area. Would you like to set a good example for others? We love sharing photos of volunteer work in action on our social media pages!
- SAFETY FIRST!** Your safety while completing volunteer work is our top priority. Please wear gloves, closed-toe shoes, long pants, and dress appropriately for the weather. Potential natural hazards include poison ivy, chiggers, and snakes in tall grass. Always look before you step!


