



#### **Growth for North Central Texas**






2020 – 2045: 3.6 million residents added to the region. **45% of this growth** will happen in Denton and Collin counties.

## **Regional Growth**


 Over 50 percent of the population growth projected to occur by 2045 is anticipated to occur outside existing incorporated areas




**Built Area Predicted** 






## Population by Housing Type




#### **Future Land Use Plan - 1982**

 3,340 or about half a Grayhawk.




#### **Future Land Use Plan**
