Virtual Comments

Crosswalks, lower speed limits-especially in residential neighborhoods

Creating pathways under major streets to connect pedestrians to venues and things to do. Right now, everything requires a car, which is not friendly.

Traffic control, variety of non chain restaurants


A transit system, slower speed limits, and dedicated bike/ hiking paths such as the ones in plano




