

RESIDENTIAL ALTERATION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

FENCE

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Fence) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

1. Property's plot plan (survey). Clearly "mark" the proposed fence placement on your property.

Note: Proposed fence replacement around a residential pool has additional requirements. For information and requirements, visit Health & Food Safety's webpage at friscotexas.gov/health.

Note: Some subdivisions require HOA approval. Please contact your HOA for approval.

STORAGE SHED / UTILITY STRUCTURE

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Other Home Improvements) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

- 1. Property's plot plan (survey). Clearly "mark" the proposed placement of the structure (include the distance to ALL property lines).
- 2. Detailed drawings (or a manufacturer's brochure) with the proposed structure's dimensions (length, width, and maximum height).

Note: Some subdivisions require HOA approval. Please contact your HOA for approval.

ARBORS, PATIO COVERS, GAZEBOS, CARPORTS, SUNROOMS, OR SIMILAR STRUCTURES

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Other Home Improvements) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

- 1. Property's plot plan (survey). Clearly "mark" the proposed placement of the structure (include the distances to ALL property lines).
- 2. Detailed framing drawings (or a manufacturer's brochure) with the proposed structure's dimensions (length, width, and maximum height), which include a front and side elevation, material list, post size, and beam size.
- 3. If proposed structure is going to be physically attached to the main structure (dwelling), include the support bracket types, bolts to be used (size & length) and what the structure will be attached to on the main structure (i.e., brick, main supports to house, etc.).
- 4. Include Footer Detail Sheet and how posts will be attached. If bolts to the slab, what will be the type of brackets, bolts, and depth of concrete slab. If placed below grade level, provide the depth of the hole and if there will be concrete, rebar, etc.
- 5. Additionally, if the structure is made of aluminum, steel, or vinyl, the structure must be engineered.

Note: Some subdivisions require HOA approval. Please contact your HOA for approval.

OUTDOOR KITCHENS & GRILLS

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Other Home Improvements) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

- 1. Property's plot plan (survey). Clearly "mark" the proposed placement of the structure (include the distance to ALL property lines).
- 2. Include the front elevation of the structure with the correct shaped dimensions, materials being used, footer details.
- 3. Type(s) of appliances (i.e., barbeque grill, refrigerator, sink, icemaker, pizza oven, ice chest, etc.). Note: Outdoor kitchen sinks and ice chests are required to drain to the sanitary sewer line.
- 4. If applicable, ensure to indicate if natural gas or propane is going to be used for any grill installation.

FIREPLACE (OUTDOOR)

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Other Home Improvements) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

- 1. Property's plot plan (survey). Clearly "mark" the proposed placement of the structure (include the distance to ALL property lines).
- 2. Include the front elevation of the fireplace with the correct shaped dimensions (including height), materials being used, and footer details.
- 3. Specify if the fireplace will have natural gas or be wood-burning.
- 4. If using a firebox insert, provide a copy of the Manufacturer's Warranty and any other details.

Note: Some subdivisions require HOA approval. Please contact your HOA for approval.

FIRE PIT: As required by the International Fire Code® (IFC), please ensure fire pit is built 15 feet from any main structure and 10' from any combustible item. This is measured from the perimeter of the fire pit to the structure or combustible material. If appliance does not comply with IFC, it must meet ANSI requirements.

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Other Home Improvements) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

- 1. Property's plot plan (survey). Clearly "mark" the proposed placement of the fire pit (include the distance to ALL property lines).
- 2. Include the elevation with dimensions.
- 3. A copy of the instruction manual.
- 4. A copy of the certificate showing it meets ANSI requirements.

Note: Some subdivisions require HOA approval. Please contact your HOA for approval.

CONCRETE & DRIVEWAY

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Other Home Improvements) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

- 1. Property's plot plan (survey). Clearly "mark" the proposed placement of the concrete (include the distance to ALL property lines).
- 2. On survey, provide specifications of concrete (depth, size and spacing of rebar, PSI required for driveway).

Note: Any work done in right-of-way (ROW) requires a separate permit from Public Works.

Note: Some subdivisions require HOA approval. Please contact your HOA for approval.

SOLAR PANEL

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Other Home Improvements) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

- 1. Stamped Engineer Letter
- 2. Stamped Engineer Structural Drawings
- 3. Stamped Engineer Electrical Drawings
- 4. Specifications for Solar Panels
- 5. Warning Labels

Note: Refer to Adopted Codes friscotexas.gov/397/Adopted-Codes

Note: Some subdivisions require HOA approval. Please contact your HOA for approval.

Note: Structures with solar panels follow patio cover (see above) and solar panel submittal requirements.

FOUNDATION REPAIR

Submit an online Residential Building Permit Application (Other Home Improvements) with the following drawings and/or documents in PDF format:

- Stamped Engineer Letter
- 2. Stamped pier drawings

Note: Engineer must provide inspection report at time of completion. Email to bicsr@friscotexas.gov.

Note: Some subdivisions require HOA approval. Please contact your HOA for approval.
