Classes are offered <u>every other month</u>. February, April, June, August, October and December. Third Wednesdays 6:30 – 9:00 p.m.

Course Description & Guidelines Classes offered for those who live or work in Frisco.

- Classes are free of charge.
- All classes are scheduled on a first come-first served basis. Our online system does provide for a wait list that will automatically register you should a spot become available.
- All classes will be held at Fire Station 6, 3535 Eldorado Parkway in Frisco. (Between Teel and Legacy, next to Griffin Middle School)
- ✤ Class time is 6:30 9:00 PM
- This class is not a certification class. No cards are issued. This class is not intended for those who need ALS/BLS Certification. It is designed for our Frisco citizens who want to gain the knowledge and skills necessary to respond in an emergency and do not have a requirement to be 'certified'.
- Persons seeking a certification course should try either <u>www.Heart.org</u> or <u>www.RedCross.org</u> to find one in your area.
- The course covers hands-only adult CPR, child and infant CPR (compressions plus breathing), choking and AED use.
- Class size is limited to 20 attendees.
- Non-residents of Frisco seeking a CPR course can check the above-mentioned websites or your local fire department.
- Class is open to those who are 10 years old and older. All attendees under 18 must have a parent accompany them to the class.
