

Plays MATER PARK rules

- Swimming is permitted only when a lifeguard is on duty.
- Guardians must be at least 18 years of age.
- Guardians of children age 6 and under must be wearing a bathing suit, in the water 3. and within arm's reach of the child at all times.
- Guardians of children age 7-11 must remain in the pool area at all times. 4.
- 5. All swimmers are required to take a cleansing shower before entering the pool.

This is a family-oriented facility; all swimmers must wear appropriate bathing suit 6. attire. No cut offs, thongs, under garments, workout clothes, street clothes or see through items allowed.

Diaper aged children are required to wear swim diapers.

Changing on the pool deck is prohibited. 8.

Anyone with open cuts, wounds or has been ill with diarrhea within the past two 9. weeks is not permitted in the pool.

10. U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices only.

Do not throw people, stand or sit on people's shoulders

12. Running, diving, flips, horseplay, breath holding games, aggressive behavior, and profane language are not allowed.

13. Swim toys are allowed at the discretion of staff.

14. Only City of Frisco issued inner tubes are permitted to be used on the Lazy River.

15. Riders of the Lazy River must always go with the current.

16. Inner tubes from the Lazy River are not allowed in the Lagoon Pool.

17. Slide riders must wait for the lifeguard signal before beginning the ride.

18. Only one person on each slide at a time.

19. Do not spray the lifeguards with the hoses and water cannons.



20. Food and non-alcoholic drinks are allowed. No glass containers.

21. Coolers are allowed but may be searched to ensure compliance with facility policies. 22. Use of cameras and/or video recording devices must have prior approval by management.

23. The City of Frisco is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

24. Animals are not allowed in the pool area.

25. Staff reserves the right to enforce other rules as necessary to ensure the safety and comfort of our members and guests.



WALNUT'S SAFETY CLUB RULES

All minors must always be under parental supervison, just as in any public space.

Lifeguards are here to respond to emergencies and should not be expected to serve as a guardian. Children should always stay within arms reach of a supervising adult.

The activities in the water park have varying levels of thrill and may have requirements based on physical and mental abilities. It is a parent's responsibility to know their child's ability and help them make decisions in their participation.

Weak or non-swimmers should wear a properly fitted life jacket. Courtesy life jackets are available throughout the water park.

Wristbands must always remain on.
